Please note the following with regard to the new academic session 2026-27:

- New session commences for classes I to X, XII from Monday, 01 April 2026.
- On normal working days, the school starts at 9.10 A.M and ends at 4.10 P.M. for all the classes from **LKG to X STD and XII**.
- You shall carefully go through the Student Planner and abide by all rules chartered therein, interact with teachers through its pages whenever you deem fit; and respond to all messages from teachers/school authority in time.
- There will be Unit Tests / Periodic Test / Term I – II for the whole year and evaluations and its result will be made available to all parents in the “**Parent - Teacher Meet (PTM)**”. Parents are requested to sign the report card, test papers, and teacher’s remarks so that they are abreast with the progress of their child. Attendance is compulsory
- Specified time is allotted to meet the respective class teachers for any clarification and get first- hand information from the Class Teacher regarding the performance/ behavior/discipline / progress of your ward - son / daughter.
- There will be activities and life skill learning on alternate working Saturdays of the month. All students are expected to participate very actively in all these activities since they are part of Evaluation.
- Students should come to school in complete school uniform from the first day itself. Please ensure that your ward comes to school neatly with defined dress code.

Transport:

- If the student needs to be picked up during the school hours due to an emergency situation, an application in writing / gate pass should be submitted at school office.
- If your ward travels to and from school in a private van, please ensure that the driver and conductor have a valid license, possess police verification documents and the van is registered with RTO, and NOT running on LPG.
- It is very important that students should immediately inform the class teacher and the school office about any change in their address/telephone number, so that we can contact them easily in case of an emergency.

Attendance:

- Application for leave of absence for up to three days has to be sent in the calendar through the Parents-Teachers Remark page.
- For leave of more than three days, **permission** from the principal is **mandatory**.
- ***In case of prolonged or infectious illness, the student will have to furnish a Medical Certificate on the day she/ he joins back.***

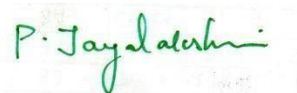
ICT Pedagogy:
